

# Attendance

Daily attendance will be taken. Being “present” is determined by **one** of three methods:

1. Teacher interaction with a student
2. Progress documented in the Google Classroom LMS platform
3. An assignment completed and turned in to the teacher through Google Classroom



# Virtual Instruction

Virtual/remote instruction will blend asynchronous and synchronous instruction.

**All grade levels will have opportunities to schedule intervention and support directly from their teacher.**

# Asynchronous Instruction

**Asynchronous Instruction** refers to self-paced instruction with intermittent teacher interaction. There is pre-assigned work with formative assessments on paper or on the Google Classroom Learning Management System (LMS). Students may also watch pre-recorded videos of instruction with guided support. **Asynchronous** student expectations include:

- Participating in a daily virtual touchpoint with the teacher, if requested.
- Showing proof of participation in daily virtual instruction by satisfactorily completing assignments to demonstrate evidence of student learning, including video, picture, or activities submitted as lessons and/or completed assignments.
- Communication with the teacher when there is a need for additional assistance or tutoring.
- Designating a work space and work times at home.

# Synchronous Instruction

**Synchronous Instruction** refers to live, scheduled, interactive classes with teachers and students in real-time, teacher-supported work time, and scheduled and timed online tests. **Synchronous** student expectations include:

- Attending class on time per teacher scheduled time.
- Dressing appropriately when participating in classes.
- Being ready and prepared to learn during class.
- Having a designated work space free from distractions.
- Showing their face on the screen to engage with the teacher and other classmates virtually.
- Participating appropriately in the class with the teacher and other students.
