



FISD Bond Steering Committee Meeting 6 Notes

Meeting 5 recap

Matt Gamble from Baselice presented the community survey results to the committee and answered questions about the survey process.

The committee was shown a recap of options with dollar amounts and a direct comparison of what the dollars can cover in each scenario.

1. New Site, New School
2. Existing Site, New School

The committee reviewed the list of other district facility needs (buses, carpeting, fencing, bleachers, etc.) to be included in the bond package.

- The committee approved over half of the items on the list in meeting 5, totaling \$1,146,283
- Remaining items that did not achieve 2/3 majority approval totaled \$826,509 and were discussed by the committee.

The committee was given a recap of FISD's bonding capacity:

1. \$67.5 M with no tax rate increase
2. \$71.5 M with a one cent tax rate increase

The Committee then shared their thoughts aloud in a group discussion, then voted on paper ballots which were collected and counted by Patricia Bosquez (FISD), Mitch McGuffie (Committee Member) and Hannah Martin (Huckabee). The results came out as follows:

- Option 1 with full list of district needs: 15
- Option 2 with full list of district needs: 4
- Option 2 with track alternate and approved needs: 1

The committee nominated four representatives to present the recommendation at the board meeting on Monday, December 14.
